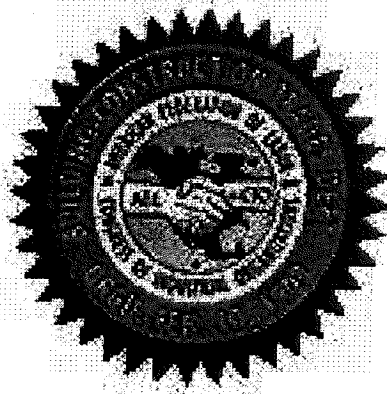

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE: Each year, the President shall appoint a Scholarship Committee consisting of no less than three (3) Delegates from the Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council. The Committee shall have the responsibility to oversee the scholarship selection process itself, for the current year. The Committee shall report its results and make recommendations to the Council body by the APRIL meeting for the current year. ***The Committee will have the final decision on all questions and disputes.***

ELIGIBILITY: The Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council Scholarship Program is open to the sons and daughters who are ***legal dependents of Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council affiliated Local Unions active and retired members***, and under the age of 24.

SCHOLARSHIPS: The number of scholarships (one time grants) and amount of each scholarship will be announced prior to the application dates for the current school year. The maximum dollar amount granted to any one winner shall not exceed the total cost of the curriculum, and must be applied directly to the cost of said curriculum. All scholarship awards shall be made out in the name of the applicant and the Institution of learning he or she is/will be attending.

STUDY REQUIREMENTS: No specific studies are required. Scholarship winners may pursue whatever courses they wish. Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) hours and accepted into or be attending an accredited university, college, community college, or an approved trade school or technical school no later than September 1 of the application year.

APPLICATIONS: Applications will be accepted during the months of January through April 30th of the application year. ***ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED AND POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN April 30th*** of the application year in order to be eligible for the current school year.

Applications will be provided by contacting any delegate to the Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council.

SELECTIONS: Winners, as well as alternates for each of the winners, are chosen by lottery at the April meeting.

NOTE TO ALL APPLICANTS

In order to be eligible for the Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council Scholarship for the following academic year, applications must be received by April 30th.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

- Fill out Section A. Answer all questions. Remember to sign your application.
- Include a short essay (no more than 250 words) on how the union has been beneficial for your family.
- Do **not** attach school transcripts or other documents to this application. Winners are selected by lottery-type drawing. Only one application per year will be accepted.
- Mail or hand-deliver the application to the Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council by April 30th.
